MATTHEW 5:1-12

[1] Seeing the crowds, he went up on the mountain, and when he sat down, his disciples came to him.

[2] And he opened his mouth and taught them, saying:

[3] “Blessed are the poor in spirit, for theirs is the kingdom of heaven.

[4] “Blessed are those who mourn, for they shall be comforted.

[5] “Blessed are the meek, for they shall inherit the earth.

[6] “Blessed are those who hunger and thirst for righteousness, for they shall be satisfied.

[7] “Blessed are the merciful, for they shall receive mercy.

[8] “Blessed are the pure in heart, for they shall see God.

[9] “Blessed are the peacemakers, for they shall be called sons of God.

[10] “Blessed are those who are persecuted for righteousness’ sake, for theirs is the kingdom of heaven.

[11] “Blessed are you when others revile you and persecute you and utter all kinds of evil against you falsely on my account. [12] Rejoice and be glad, for your reward is great in heaven, for so they persecuted the prophets who were before you. (ESV)

Reflection Questions:

1. Where do you most feel that division in your own life right now? What desire or habit competes most loudly with your desire for God?
2. King David says in his psalm, “create in me a clean heart.” He didn’t say fix or improve. What does it mean to you that heart-purity is something God must originate, not something you can manufacture through more effort or willpower?
3. The refiner sits and watches — attentively, patiently — until the work is done. Is there a current season of difficulty or pain in your life that you might be able to see differently through this image? What would it mean to trust that God’s eyes have not left you through it?
